Student Responsibilities (initial each arrow after reading)





-  1. Completely read and sign the “PADI Standard Safe Diving Practices Statement of Understanding” and the “Release of Liability/Assumption of Risk/Non-Agency Acknowledgement” forms before the first class session, don’t forget to ask the DDD staff if you have any questions before signing!
-  2. Answer the Medical History questionnaire honestly with a complete and legible “YES” or “NO” in each question space. If you answer “YES” to any question, notify DDD staff **PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED CLASS START DATE**. We will provide you with a medical release form that you will take to a physician to receive a medical clearance **BEFORE ANY IN-WATER TRAINING**.
-  3. **COMPLETE YOUR INDEPENDENT STUDY PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED CLASS START DATE.**
This means:
 - Read the assigned chapter in your student manual and complete the Knowledge Reviews at the end of that chapter.
 - Watch the assigned Open Water Course videos.
 - Read all of the PADI Recreational Dive Planner (RDP) handbook and practices with the RDP table version.
-  4. DDD staff and Instructors reserve the right to reschedule training sessions for any student that has not completed their assigned independent study **PRIOR** to the classroom training sessions or arrives **LATE** for any training session. Any make-up classes will be charged a \$95 make-up fee per session.
-  5. Provided logbook is required material and should accompany you to all training events. If you lose this logbook, you will be required to purchase another in order to maintain the tracking of your training.
-  6. Possess an appropriate scuba quality mask, snorkel, fins, booties, weight belt and 15 lbs of weight, before the first confined water (pool) training session. These items are available in the dive shop here at Down Deep Diving LLC, at a great discount!
-  7. Follow all course procedures and directions of your instructor. Ask questions of your DDD professional staff if you have any questions about your training.
-  8. Accept financial responsibility for any lost, damaged, or missing rental/loaner scuba equipment assigned to you during the class; and return all rental/loaner equipment to DDD when instructed to.
-  9. Be aware that DDD requires students complete the course within six (6) months of the start of the class to ensure knowledge retention. If you fail to complete the course within six months DDD reserves the right to require you to repeat the entire class at full price to achieve certification

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Open Water Checkout

Student Responsibilities (initial each arrow after reading)

-  1. Lodging will be provided by DDD at a double occupancy rate that is included in your checkout Payment of \$_____. If Single occupancy is requested there will be an additional fee.
-  2. Only paying customers of DDD may stay in any room purchased by DDD.
-  3. If you have not purchased your SCUBA Regulator and BCD by the checkout, DDD will rent said items for \$_____ for the checkout week end.
-  4. If all four (4) check out dives are not made successfully and all skills are not performed adequately a certification card will not be issued. DDD has at least 3 check out dives per year. You are encouraged to go on the next available Check out dive.

Advanced Open Water Class

Student Responsibilities (initial each arrow after reading)

-  1. Possess an appropriate scuba quality mask, snorkel, fins, booties, weight belt, 15 lbs of weight, Compass, DSMB, 2 flashlights, Dive tool, Regulators with either a computer or console, BCD, before the Start of the class. These items are available in the dive shop here at Down Deep Diving LLC, at a great discount!
-  2. All advanced diver checkouts will contain at least 4 Salt Water dives.

DDD Staff Responsibilities

- 1. Provide a schedule of training sessions and start the class as scheduled.
- 2. Provide a positive learning environment in which to master the course objectives.
- 3. Provide a telephone or contact number(s) for students to make direct contact with their instructor(s) for notifications in the event of being late or absent, or to ask general questions related to their training.
